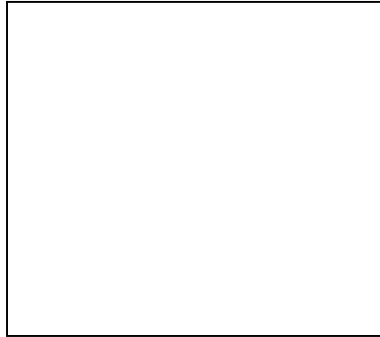
# Presenting Christ as Savior

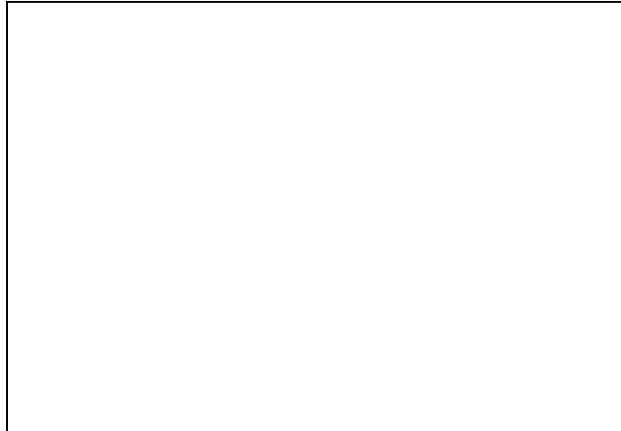
